Children's Ministry

We wholeheartedly believe in ministering to children! In Sunday School (9:00 AM), we provide classes for Preschool, Elementary, and Teens. In the worship service (10:30 AM), during the sermon, we provide Children's Church for ages 6 and below, and nursery care. Our aim is that the children will grow and mature as they are taught God's Word. We desire that children will learn to worship the Lord with the rest of the congregation, and to listen to and grow from the sermons in the worship service. So, we provide help to parents in teaching their children to do so. As Pastor Steve preaches, he seeks to engage all ages with the Word of God, down to the youngest ones.

Design of Our Worship Services

We aim to worship God by singing as a congregation praises to our God and Savior; listening to the reading of Scripture with hearts to apply it; being led in prayers of adoration, thanksgiving, confession, and supplication; and listening with faith to the expository preaching of God's Word in order to be transformed into the likeness of Christ. The worship service on the Lord's Day is the most important part of our week, so we devote ourselves to it wholeheartedly, and the service lasts close to two hours. Because the most fundamental form of worship is listening to, believing, and obeying God's Word, we devote about an hour to the preaching. The preaching aims to declare the whole counsel of Scripture. Rather than using the Bible as a springboard to proclaim our own thoughts, we study carefully through whole books of the Bible, hearing what God's Word says in context, and what it means for our lives. In all these things, we seek upmost the glory of God!
